

# Why LMI?

Labour Market Information (LMI) is at the centre of effective information, advice and guidance.

An understanding of the LMI helps individuals to realise their occupational aspirations;

- Informs career decision-making
- Promotes lifelong learning
- Reinforces the importance of skills development
- Aids in long term career planning
- Changes the way people search for and apply for work
- Enables empowerment

## What is LMI?

LMI is a mix of data, statistics, research and practical experience about the world of work.

- 1) What jobs are available in your area
  - Incl. locations, industry types, and earnings
- 2) What type of opportunities are available and routes to employment
  - FT or PT work and/or education, Apprenticeships and Trainee placements
- 3) Insight into competition
  - No. of people looking for employment, and skills which employers need
- 4) Future trends
  - How the job market and workforce is likely to change i.e. growth industry
- 5) Exposure with employers and industry exp. [Real-world Info]








# % share for SW occupations: all Industries






# SW: projections for employment






